Your polling place is determined by your registered address. If you are going to be away on Election Day, you may request an absentee ballot. This is a two-step process requiring a written application to the Board of Elections (215-348-6154). The ballot will be mailed to you. Complete and return .

Last day to register to vote in May primary	April 19
Last day to request an absentee ballot	May 11
Last day absentee ballot may be received by Board of Elections	May 14
Primary Election (7 a.m. – 8 p.m.)	May 18
Registration resumes	May 19 to Oct 4
Last day to request an absentee ballot	Oct 26
Last day absentee ballot may be received	Oct 29
General Election (7 a.m. – 8 p.m)	Nov 2
